Policy for GYO Property Rental

GYO give benefit to its members by allowing them to use GYO property without a cost; however, no one is allowed to misuse these properties under any circumstances. To safeguard these properties, GYO have put together a list of feasible conditions that must be abide by:

1. Any member can use a GYO property for his/her own event or on the behalf of a non member; however, GYO requires a **deposit of \$50**, this money will be given back upon return of the property – no exception! The property must be returned before 5:00pm if the event falls on a meeting weekend. Subsequently, if the event falls on weekend other than meeting weekend, the property must be returned within 24 hours from the time it was taken from our premises. Nonetheless, a member can renew this rental. This is optional provided that no one needs to use that property. If the person using the property fails to return it within the given time frame, GYO would promptly pick up the property from the person's home or location where the property is and any cost incurred shall be subtracted from the security deposit.
2. Any broken property will be replaced (a fee of current cost of the property will be forfeited from the security deposit).
3. This authorization form must be signed and dated before taking the property from the premises.
4. GYO Properties are currently stored at our meeting location (1305 Sheridan Ave, #6C, Bronx, NY 10456) and must be returned to this location after every usage.
5. A member who takes GYO property on the behalf of non members is responsible for the property and he or she must adhere to the above agreement and pay any penalty imposed.

PRO Benefit Criteria Enacted 07/06/08

1. GYO are oblige to attend and support by collecting petit cash for any GYO members' program or occasion either the member is in NYC or elsewhere. However, the member has to be in good standing. The occasion or program can only be supported by GYO members, if the recipient acknowledges us a week in advance. If the distance to travel is far, thus no GYO member is available to attend, collection must be sent forthwith.
2. If a close relative or an acquaintance of a member in good standing has a program or occasion, that member related to this person can call GYO members privately to inform them; however, informing GYO members should not be done publicly in GYO gathering of any kind. Public Relation Department must not involve in call people in this regard. For members in good standing, their spouse and parents (mother and father) are not subjected to this rule. In case a member in good standing inform GYO about his/her spouse, mother, father and children's occasion or program, that will be treated as this member own program or occasion.
3. GYO sister, Board members and other Goodwill supporters of GYO either in kind or cash, these people should be recognized and treat as our own; thus, GYO will participate and collect petit cash for any of their occasion. However, Public Relation Department will determine if these people have track record of fraternity with GYO.

GYO Media Advertisement Press Release

Although GYO is not affiliated with any political parties, GYO information can be advertised through press release by the new and media department. The New Media coordinator must write the press release and send it to the executive for review; if agreeable, the information will be sent to all media outlet.

Soccer Players Benefit

GYO members and non members who play for organization and in that process get injury, the individual shall be entitled to the current \$500 compensation plus petite cash collected from individual donors. However, if a player gets injured playing for another team, GYO can only collect petite cash from individual donors as goodwill.

Executive Decisions

In the case of emergency the executive members will be contacted to make decisions. The decisions taken will be based on the quorum of the executive. If in a split second, a decision needs to be made and the executive are not reaching in a timely manner, the president can make the decision and later explain why he made the decision.

Everyone hold one Position

After GYO 2008 election, every member is eligible for one position. Unless, a position is unoccupied, and there is no one currently holding that position, an executive member can volunteer to temporarily hold the position.

GYO Musical Instrument Rental – 02/07/2010

Weeks before this date (Feb. 7th, 2010), GYO executive had a conference call about renting GYO musical instrument to GYO Members and non Members. For GYO members, anyone renting the musical instrument must pay \$250. This includes the fees for DJ (complimentary \$50 services) and transportation (approx. \$50). If the member can afford the transportation of the music set under the supervision of a GYO DJ or GYO officer, he or she gets back \$50 transportation discount. For non GYO members who want to rent the equipment, they must pay \$300. This payment also includes \$100 compensation for the GYO DJ and \$50 for transportation of the equipment. If the transport of the equipment back and forth cost more than the estimated \$50, GYO is willing to accept any amount the DJ presents after subtracting the expenses. Only a GYO member who rents the music set for his/her event gets the discount (\$250). Absolutely a GYO member who rents the set on behalf of a non GYO member will not get the discount.
